- 2) Ensure lead is in 2 way operation mode
- 3) 2 way operation red LED is lit








Series 20 manual limit setting procedure

 Drive blind to approximately mid position – thereby determining the direction of movement of the blind on the switch (you must allow at least 30cm of movement to the nearest limit setting position).



- Press the up and down buttons on the test lead (or handset) together, after approx. 5 sec. motor will respond with a short up and down movement.
- ⇒ Limits are erased. Motor is now in limit setting mode


Series 20 manual limit setting procedure

- Hold the down button until motor 'jolts' and increases speed then continue pressing down button until blind is at required position.
 - (To get to an accurate limit position release the button and pulse in the same direction with the same button in small movements).
- 4. Press and hold the up button until motor stops automatically (approx 30 cm movement).Release the up button

 \Rightarrow Lower position is set

(To get to an accurate limit position release the button and pulse in the same direction with the same button in small movements).


 Press and hold the down button until motor stops automatically (approx 30 cm movement).
