

Fabric Joining Information for Wave and SWISS Pleat Curtains

By reducing the number of joins the overall curtain appearance improves. The table below indicates the maximum drop available **without** joins for each fabric.

We recommend (for Wave) that if dim-out and black-out fabrics have to be made with joins (due to the drop required - see above table) then they should be lined to reduce pinholes.

*Our Wave curtain heading system is designed to encourage fabric to hang in a soft, continuous wave form from the top to the bottom of the curtain. However, the weave and design of some fabrics does not allow this floor-to-ceiling shape when using the 60mm glider cord. Therefore, we do not recommend the following fabrics are specified with 60mm Wave glider-cord:

- *Leviso
- *Leviso Light
- *Somnia
- *Colorama Dimout
- *Multicolour Panama
- *Multicolour Natrura
- *Multicolour Dimout
- *Deep

**Colorama Dimout is not suitable for drops over 2.8m
